

COVID-19: Spot the Symptoms

Headache

A dull ache, throbbing sensation or sharp pain in any region of your head.

Fever

In adults, a body temperature of 100.4°F or higher.

Sneezing

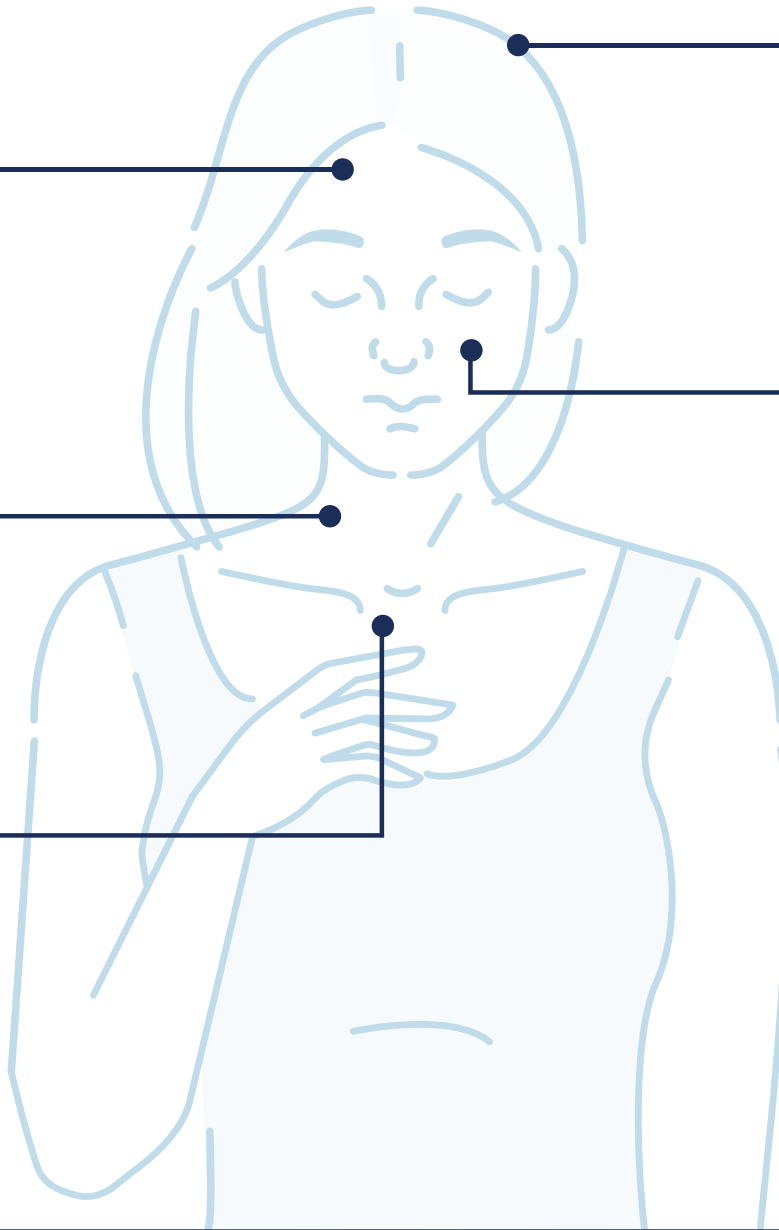
A natural reaction to viruses that infect your respiratory system.

Dry cough

No phlegm or mucus. May feel itchy or irritated.

Shortness of breath

Seems to begin after a week of infection. Feels like you can't get enough air into your lungs to comfortably breathe.



Most people with COVID-19 develop only mild symptoms, but people over 60 and those with other health conditions may develop more serious symptoms, including pneumonia and kidney failure.
